One Day Itinerary

9 a.m. - 9:45 a.m. - Blennerhassett Museum of Regional History

Take the self guided tour of the museum, view three levels of artifacts and watch the video explaining the lives of Harman and Margret Blennerhassett. Purchase Sternwheeler tickets at the front desk then head down to Point Park.

10 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. - Blennerhassett Island Historical State Park

Take a guided tour through the Blennerhassett's reconstructed mansion, take a horse-drawn wagon ride around the property and hear the history surrounding this enchanted river island.

The sternwheeler leaves Point Park at the top of the hour and leaves the island on the half hour.

Allow more time if you want to explore this island at your own leisure or special events)

3 p.m. - 5 p.m. - Henderson Hall (25 minute drive from Point Park)

Visit Henderson Hall and learn how Mr. Henderson foiled the traitorous plans of his neighbor, Harmon Blennerhassett and Aaron Burr. And view the original antiques that the Henderson family has preserved for generations.

Note: Blennerhassett Island & Henderson Hall and other locations are closed on Mondays

Lunch Options:

- Pack a picnic lunch
- Purchase snacks at the Snack Bar
- *Groups can contact the museum and have box lunches served on the island.
- Eat at the Point Park Marketplace next to the flood wall

Other Things to See & Do:

- Fort Boreman Historical Park - Civil War history, overlook, play ground, picnic area, and hiking trails.
- Point Park Marketplace - Handmade items, seasonal produce, dining options. (BBQ, Pizza and sweet treats)
- Oil & Gas Museum - Discover the birthplace of the oil and gas industry along with Civil War artifacts.
- Holls Chocolate - Stop in and get a free piece of freshly made Swiss chocolate.
- Julia-Ann Historic District - Self-guided walking tour.
